Trackpro read the following headline in Sunday's Bloodhorse Daily Magazine:

Trackpro subscriber's get treated to plenty of **upset** horses in the reports that make racing headlines. Not everyday of course, but on most racing days, there

are usually plenty of overlooked horses on the tote board that present excellent wagering value. For example, the powerful Trackpro Value Rating (TPV) software listed the #9 RHETORICAL (\$21.18) second in the report for subscriber's on Saturday afternoon at lovely Keeneland Race Course! The #9 RHETORICAL (\$21.18) won the Grade 1 Turf Mile which had a purse of \$1,250,000. And not only that, this winner "keyed" the listed \$2.00 Exacta which paid a hefty \$100.78. And the listed \$2.00 Triple padded fan wagering accounts to the tune of \$512.80! And make no mistake, very few professional handicapping services listed this well bred four year old gelding in their reports, or even in their top five selections! And what is even more amazing is that I could not find any competing websites that listed the Triple which is probably why it paid a huge \$512.80! In the Turf Club Newsletter on Saturday morning on October 4th, Trackpro made the following statement: "So clearly, the Trackpro reports contain tons of wagering value on most days, and it goes without saying that subscriber's can do very well by just sticking to the TOP TWO SELECTIONS when the odds are high on the tote board." Sure enough, the #9 RHETORICAL (\$21.18) was listed second in the selections shown above with the morning line set at 8-1 which was the highest morning line from the top two picks! And note the winner was marked with a total of seven Trackpro Handicapping Tools, and the algorithm also marked the horse as the TOP BET VALUE (V) selection to boot!

For some reason, neither the betting public, nor the Bris Prime Power algorithm shown above in the past performances thought the winner had much of a chance despite the top connections, the top pedigree, and the multiple "big wins" in this gelding's last five races. It all made perfect sense from a handicapping perspective did it not? It sure did, and the **TPV** did an outstanding job handicapping this eleven horse field nailing both the exacta and triple at above average odds! There can no doubt that the track odds at post time at over **9-1** made no sense whatsoever. Why? Well, considering this gelding left the gate below even money in his last four consecutive races, three of which were won easily, I think most folks would agree the horse was a huge overlay at those odds.

And **Trackpro** wants to tip his hat to Will Walden, the trainer of the #9 RHETORICAL (**\$21.18**) who won his first Grade 1 Stakes of his career. From Bloodhorse Daily: "It was a monumental victory for Walden as he earned his first at the grade 1 level. Son of Belmont Stakes (G1)-winning trainer and WinStar Farm president, CEO, and racing manager Elliott Walden, Will Walden began training in 2022 after years of battling alcohol and drug addiction. Walden was

involved in a downtown Lexington program to aid in his recovery from addiction when he was connected with Taylor Made Farm's Frank Taylor. Taylor took a chance and bought 10 horses for Walden, Mike Lowery, and Tyler Maxwell to train. Lowery now works for Taylor Made, managing 250 horses and 25 employees, and Maxwell is a leading rider at WinStar Farm. "They worked very hard, and Will's a very, very talented horseman," Taylor said after joining Walden in the winner's circle. "They all stayed sober, and they've all become hugely successful. God blesses you for doing the right thing, and this is just a prime example."

In R8 at Keeneland on Saturday, the industrial strength **TPV** algorithm listed the #4 SIMPLY IN FRONT (**\$28.34**) second in the handicapped report, and marked as a **Super Value** (**SV**) Win Bet! Once again, a huge longshot was listed in the **TOP TWO SELECTIONS** for subscriber's!

The listed \$2.00 Exacta Super Value (SV) "key" paid \$174.98. And the listed \$2.00 Triple "key" paid a wallet-busting \$1,207.32! Talk about wagering value, it just does not get better than this! Notice the #1 SIMPLY IN FRONT (\$28.24) was marked with a total of four Handicapping Tools on the horse itself, the Same Jockey (#) Ben Curtis (15.58%) was returning to ride, and the TPV marked this horse as having the TOP CLASS (C) from the listed selections. What was not to like with odds on the tote board a full five points over the 8-1 morning line at post time? Not much, that is for darn sure! From Bloodhorse

Daily: "It seemed only fitting that jockey Ben Curtis' first grade 1 win would come aboard a horse trained by Eddie Kenneally. "I came over for Eddie many moons ago. In the winter, there was no racing in Ireland, so I came over and (worked for him at Palm Meadows Training Center in Florida)," Curtis said. "He used to tell me I was breezing them all wrong and getting it all wrong," Curtis remarked with a wry smile. Curtis and Kenneally combined to win their first graded stakes together with the fast-improving Simply in Front in the \$776,750 First Lady Stakes (G1T) Oct. 4 at Keeneland. "It's great to come over here and get a big win like this for (Kenneally) because he put me on a lot of winners, and really got me established." Curtis said. Saturday's race was only the second time that Curtis had ridden Simply in Front. The first time came in the Aug. 30 Ladies Turf Sprint Stakes (G2T) at Kentucky Downs, where the pair fell three-quarters of a length short of catching Ag Bullet in a stirring stretch drive. "The key was to get her to relax," Curtis said. "We've seen that finish she's produced a few times, at Ellis and Churchill. She really closes up the stretch. So I gave her every chance and when a seam came I put her in there and she did the rest. I just enjoyed the ride. She's a filly who enjoys her job." The **TPV** algorithm certainly did its job well too when parsing the past performances did it not? A massive listed

triple which paid \$1,207.32 for subscriber's in the eleven horse field! The TPV also listed the late 50 cent PICK 4 (2 x 2 x 2 x 2) in R11 that returned a solid \$593.92 in the TOP TWO SELECTIONS! And it was not just on Saturday at Keeneland that the algorithm listed huge payoffs for subscriber's. Check out the listed "Double Overlay" Daily Double below from yesterday's racing at Keeneland
